Dear Parents/Carers,


We are writing to ask you for your support managing allergens in the academy. As you may be aware some of our students have serious allergies that can be life threatening. We already operate a 'Nut Free School' policy however there are certain additional allergens that we also need to make sure are not brought into school. This will enable us to keep our students and students safe.

Please could you ensure that the following are not brought into the academy or taken in packed lunches on trips.

- Nuts/tree nuts - Such as peanuts, hazelnuts, almonds and cashews etc. Anything that contains nuts such as cereal/granola bars, biscuits, nut butters and breads containing nuts.
- Seeds - such as sesame seeds, including seeded bread and bread buns.
- Body sprays, perfumes, hand creams and lip balms containing nuts and oils, such as coconut and almonds.
