National Education Union - strike action for teachers

As you may have seen, the National Education Union (NEU) has confirmed that their teaching members will be taking industrial action in the form of strike days. The next scheduled dates are **Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July**.

This action is not against Outwood Academy Newbold itself but is part of national industrial action organised by the trade unions about salary negotiations with the Department for Education.

Neither the Outwood Grange Academies Trust Board nor myself as Principal are legally allowed to close the academy in sympathy with the strike, and we will not do so. However, our main concern is the health and safety of our students. The academy will only close (partially or fully) if, in our opinion and following a full risk assessment, it is not safe to remain open.

Due to the number of staff taking action, we have made the difficult decision to partially close the academy on the 5th July and 7th July to most students in Years 8 - 10 (new academic year groups) with the exception of any vulnerable students who will be expected to attend as normal. We will notify individual families directly if their sons or daughters are expected to attend as a vulnerable student. The same criteria will be used as for the last strike days.

A summary of the arrangements is shown below:

Year	Students expected to attend for both Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July.
Post-16 & "New" Y11 (Miss Martin's year group)	All students will follow their normal timetable (including enrichments).
8, 9 & 10 (Mrs Sheldon, Mrs Nicholas & Mrs Waterstone)	Invited students only.

Whilst the academy will be closed to some students, online learning via Google Classroom will be available to all students and students will be expected to complete the work set.
